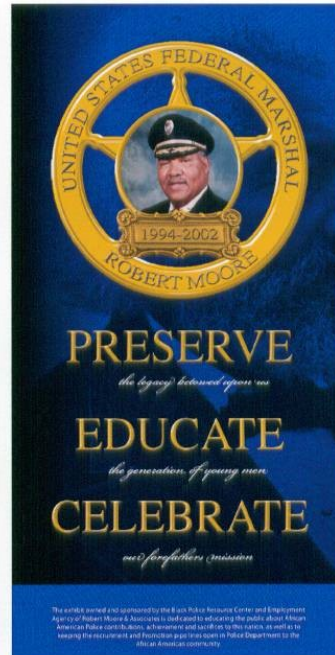


Exhibit “The President Men: Black United States Marshals
